

Telephone and Fax Numbers Pertaining to Arranging Hospitalizations

In arranging for an inpatient admission here are some numbers you will need: (*Note: Private hospitals that are specifically psychiatric cannot accept Adult Medicaid ages 21 to 64*) **List is updated frequently as numbers and admission criteria change.*

Behavioral Healthcare of Cape Fear Valley Health, Fayetteville: Adults only: Can accept Medicaid. 1-910-609-3601. Also, 910-609-3600. (Previously known as Cumberland Hospital.)

Brynn Marr Hospital: Jacksonville 1-800-822-9507 ages 5 - through adulthood. Cannot accept adult Medicaid under age 64. (*Also a Diversion site for MH/DD when Cherry Hospital is on diversion (i.e., full)*) Fax: 910-577-2767.

Behavioral Health Center, Beaufort County Hospital. Adults only Accepts Medicaid. Tel: 1-252-975-4416, Fax: 1-252-948-4833.

Coastal Plain Counseling Center and Hospital 1-800-234-0234 adults only. Will accept Medicaid. (Also a Diversion site for MH/DD)

Duplin General Hospital, Kenansville. Adults only. Accepts involuntary commitments. 1-910-296-2786, 1-910-296-2787. Accepts Medicaid on adults of all ages. Fax: 910-296-2949.

Eastpointe Number to call when needing an “**Authorization** number” for an admission to a state facility, or when needing an “**Exception**” completed for a violent/aggressive developmentally disabled (DD) “respondent” (person on commitment papers) who has been denied admission at at least three private hospitals –and, you are now seeking an admission to Cherry Hospital or other public-state facility. → 1-800-913-6109

Holly Hill Hospital -Charter Behavioral Health System, Raleigh 919-250-7000 ages 8 through adulthood. Cannot accept adult Medicaid ages 21 – 64) (*Holly Hill is also a diversion hospital accepting patients when Cherry Hospital is on diversion (i.e., full)*)
